Value of Grant: \$10,000

Eligibility Criteria:

- Canadian citizen or permanent Canadian resident (holders of study permits or temporary resident visas are not eligible);
- In September 2010, entering the **second year of a full-time post-secondary** professional training program in contemporary dance at a qualified Canadian educational or training institution;
- Be nominated by the institution.
- Previous recipients of this grant are not eligible.
