Eight **Developing Artists Grants** of \$10,000 each are awarded annually: one in classical music (orchestral instrument), classical music (piano), classical vocal performance, classical ballet, contemporary dance, jazz performance, acting (English theatre) and acting (French theatre).

- Canadian citizen or permanent Canadian resident (holders of study permits or temporary resident visas are not eligible);
- Entering in Sept. 2011 the **final year** of a full-time **post-secondary** professional training program in acting for French-language theatre at a qualified Canadian educational or training institution;
- Be nominated by the institution;
- Previous recipients of this grant are not eligible.
