Keith Dyrda, a native of Oakbank, MB, won the Hnatyshyn Foundation Developing Artist Grant for Orchestral Instrument in 2007. Just three years later, the Ottawa Citizen declared him the “Gretzky of the trombone”. He joined the Canadian Brass in April this year and, at age 21, is currently their youngest player. His brother, Jeffrey, is also a Hnatyshyn award winner.
